Lesson Plan

Student, Student, Teacher

Lesson Plan for *Teachers*

Grade 1

Objective

To help students identify the main topic and retell key details of the text.

Things Needed

- *Teachers* book
- A large, clear space for an active game

Before the Activity

Have the students sit in a large circle on the ground. Read *Teachers* out loud to students.

Activity

As a class, brainstorm the answers to the following questions:

- What do teachers do? (Possible Answers: They teach students; they help students learn; they use textbooks and ask questions; they give homework, etc.)
- What do students do? (Possible Answers: They learn from teachers; they go to school; they do homework, etc.)

Explain to students that they will play a game called Student, Student, Teacher. One person will walk around the circle and tap each person on the head. The tapper will say “student” each time. When the tapper finally says “teacher,” the player tapped on the head must stand and chase the tapper while the tapper runs around the circle and tries to sit where the “teacher” had been sitting. If the tapper succeeds, then the “teacher” becomes the next tapper. If the “teacher” tags the tapper before the tapper can sit down, the “teacher” returns to his or her spot and the tapper must try again.



Evaluation

Could students recall what teachers and students do?
