French Fry Flags

Lesson Plan for *French Fries*

Grade 1

Objective

To help students practice recalling specific details from a text, and to explore the many countries involved in the creation of French fries.

Things Needed

- *French Fries* book
- “French Fry Flags” worksheet (attached)

Before the Activity

Read *French Fries* out loud to students. Print a copy of the “French Fry Flags” worksheet for each student.

Activity

French Fries explores the history of this popular food. It mentions facts about several different countries around the world. Give each student a copy of the “French Fry Flags” worksheet. Students should draw a line connecting each country and flag on the left side of the page to the sentence describing something that happened in that country.

Evaluation

Use the answer key to give students 1 point for each correct answer.
